Pat Trainor and Dave Byers are working on an irrigation system for the pond. Mrs Fisher and Melanie Vining are developing interpretive signs for the pond using drawings from Larry Russell and Nancy Thompson. CERC painted the picnic tables and did general area maintenance.

More plantings will occur this Fall as well as the installation of a permanent outhouse structure. We are looking forward to seeing students use the area for recreation and natural resource education projects.
